

Q.1. How do you assess your knowledge and confidence on M&E in the context of NQF after this series of webinars?










Q.2. Which themes of the webinar series did you attend?










Q.3. Which of the themes in the webinar series did you find the most useful?










Q.4. How confident do you feel now to design the Results Framework for your NQF?










Q.5. How useful are the four country case studies presented in the final M&E webinar?










Q.6. How important and urgent do you think the establishment of an operational M&E system for the NQF is within your country?










Q.7. What are the key barriers to implementing an M&E system in your institution?


